SYNOPSIS

Permits State Real Estate Appraiser Board to revoke, suspend, or fine appraisers or appraisal management companies who knowingly engage in discriminatory appraisals of residential property on basis of race or national origin.

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1 AN ACT concerning real estate appraisals and supplementing 2 P.L.1991, c.68. 3 4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 5 of New Jersey: 6 7 1. a. A holder of a license or certification under P.L.1991, c.68 8 (C.45:14F-1 et seq.) or registration under P.L.2017, c.72 (C.45:14F-9 27 et al.) shall not discriminate in the appraisal of a residential 10 property on the basis of the race, creed, color, or national origin of 11 the property buyer or property seller. 12 If the board determines, after appropriate investigation, that b. 13 the holder of a license, certification, or registration has knowingly engaged in the discriminatory appraisal of a residential property on 14 15 the basis of the property buyer's or property holder's race, creed, 16 color, or national origin, the board may suspend or revoke the 17 license, certification or registration, levy a fine, or impose a civil 18 penalty. 19 20 2. Whenever the board finds cause to fine or suspend or revoke 21 the license, certification or registration of a holder, the board shall 22 notify the holder of the reasons therefor, in writing, and provide 23 opportunity for a hearing in accordance with the "Administrative 24 Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.). 25 26 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 27 28 29 **STATEMENT** 30 31 This bill permits the State Real Estate Appraiser Board to 32 revoke, suspend or fine appraisers or appraisal management 33 companies who knowingly engage in a discriminatory appraisal of a 34 residential property on the basis of the property buyer or property 35 holder's race or national origin. Under this bill, holders of appraisal licenses or certifications, or 36 37 appraisal management company registrations, may have their 38 licenses, certifications or registrations revoked or suspended, or be 39 subject to fines, if the board determines, after an appropriate 40 investigation, that the holder of the license, certification or 41 registration has knowingly engaged in a discriminatory appraisal of 42 a residential property on the basis of the property buyer or property 43 holder's race, creed, color, or national origin. 44 If the board finds cause to suspend, revoke or fine a holder of a 45 license, certification or registration, then the board is required to 46 notify the holder of the board's rationale in writing. The board must also provide opportunity for a hearing to be held in accordance 47 with the State's Administrative Procedure Act. 48
